Colossians 3:18 - 4:1

<u>CH.3</u>

[18] Wives, submit to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

[19] Husbands, love your wives, and do not be harsh with them.

[20] Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.

[21] Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.

[22] Bondservants, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters, not by way of

eye-service, as people-pleasers, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord.

[23] Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men,

[24] *knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ.*

[25] For the wrongdoer will be paid back for the wrong he has done, and there is no partiality.

[1] Masters, treat your bondservants justly and fairly, knowing that you also have a Master in heaven.

Matthew 5:13-16

You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under

In the same way, let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.

Ephesians 5:22-24

Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands.

Ephesians 6:5-8

Bondservants, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, with a sincere heart, as you would Christ, not by the way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man, knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether he is a bondservant or is free. 1 Timothy 6:1

Let all who are under a yoke as bondservants[a] regard their own masters as worthy of all honor, so that the name of God and the teaching may not be reviled.

<u>Galatians 6:7</u> Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap.

Relating to Colossians 4:1 <u>A Word For Masters</u>

Ephesians 6:9

Masters, do the same to them, and stop your threatening, knowing that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with him.
