Galatians 1:1-5

[1] *Paul, an apostle—not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him from the dead—*

[2] *and all the brothers who are with me,*

To the churches of Galatia:

[3] *Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,*

[4] *who gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father,*

[5] *to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen.*

Relating to Verses 1-2

Acts 14:14 (Barnabas as an Apostle)

But when the apostles Barnabas and Paul heard of it, they tore their garments and rushed out into the crowd, crying out

1 Thessalonians 2:6 (Timothy as an Apostle)

Nor did we seek glory from people, whether from you or from others, though we could have made demands as apostles of Christ.

1 Thessalonians 1:1 (Silas/Silvanus as an Apostle)

Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace.

Acts 1:22

beginning from the baptism of John until the day when he was taken up from us—one of these men must become with us a witness to his resurrection.

1 Corinthians 15:5-8

and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have fallen asleep. Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles. Last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to me.

John 13:20
